- arguments for and against Simultaneous Electronic Voting in the States of Deliberation (SEV);
- the costs of different systems of SEV;
- the practical and procedural effects of establishing SEV;

which report shall be presented to the States as expeditiously as possible.".

The purpose of this amendment is to afford the States the opportunity to consider Simultaneous Electronic Voting in the States of Deliberation in the context of a balanced and comprehensive report on the matter.
