- 1. To delete Proposition 3 and substitute therefor:
 - "3. To endorse the Department's intentions in respect of the promotion of electoral registration as set out in Section 6 of that Report, but subject to the modifications that application forms shall be sent out to every household rather than every dwelling and to instruct the Department not to appoint an external PR company unless and until it considers that the initial response resulting from the provision of application forms to households has proved unsatisfactory."
- 2. To insert a further proposition, between Propositions 3 and 4, as follows:
 - "3A. To direct the Department to report to the States of Deliberation by no later than April, 2011 with proposals for requiring householders to make compulsory returns in advance of a General Election in respect of all persons resident in their households, in which each such person's full name, date of birth, nationality and period of residence in Guernsey shall be provided, together with a signed declaration from each such person who is eligible to be included on the Electoral Roll as to whether he or she wishes to be so included."
