## Public Services Department Recycling Targets

To insert a new proposition between Propositions 4 and 5:

"4A. To direct the Public Services Department to introduce as soon as reasonably practicable arrangements to enable the recycling of polypropylene (PP 5)."

#### **Explanatory note**

In order to increase recycling of domestic waste and so extend the lifespan of landfill, the purpose of this amendment is to direct the Public Services Department to introduce facilities for recycling polypropylene as soon as practicable. The types of container that will be covered include food trays, ice cream containers and flower pots, where these are marked with the recycling logo and the number 5 or PP.

As demonstrated by Table 3 on page 1166 of Billet d'État No. XIX of 2010 (the States Strategic Plan 2010-2015), the various projects associated with waste that had been submitted as New Service Developments can be funded from other sources, ie, tipping charges, and the same applies if this amendment is approved.
