To insert at the end of the words in the Proposition:

- ", but to direct that in respect of any significant waste planning applications all of the Inspector's findings and observations should be taken into account, and particularly:
 - 1. That all necessary licences and permits will be obtained prior to planning permission being granted.
 - 2. That the Public Health Department will enforce the necessary standards, especially with respect to pollution control and environmental protection, and effects on the health of neighbours.
 - 3. That the Environment Department will not give permission for a plant structure that had a significant larger capacity than necessary, and that every effort is made to re-use and recycle the waste.
 - 4. That Planning Policy needs to be sufficiently flexible to permit approval of the best technical solutions available for the treatment and disposal of the Island's waste.".
