Projet de Loi entitled "The Education (Guernsey) (Amendment) Law, 2008"

In the Projet de Loi entitled "The Education (Guernsey) (Amendment) Law, 2008", in subsections (2), (3) and (5) of section 49 of the Education (Guernsey) Law, 1970 (inserted by clause 5 of the Projet and printed on pages 65 – 69 of the Brochure) delete "loans,", "any loans or" and "loan," wherever appearing in those subsections.

Explanatory note

Section 49 of the Education (Guernsey) Law, 1970 (as inserted by clause 5 of the Projet) enables the Education Department to make loans, grants and allowances for the purpose of enabling persons to take advantage of any educational facilities available to them. The amendment would restrict the powers of the Department by enabling it to make only grants and allowances (and no loans at all) as it does under the current version of section 49 of the 1970 Law.
