Right to make a claim to pay a Self-employed or Non-employed contribution / Ordinarily Resident

Any person ordinarily resident in Guernsey or Alderney has a right to make a claim to pay a self-employed or non-employed contribution based upon that person's income.

For this purpose a person is ordinarily resident in Guernsey or Alderney if he normally lives there, apart from temporary or occasional absences, and has a settled and regular mode of life here. A person may be ordinarily resident in Guernsey or Alderney although he is temporarily absent and in some circumstances he may be ordinarily resident in two places at the same time.

When a person is abroad, the question whether or not he remains ordinarily resident in Guernsey or Alderney depends on his individual circumstances. In order to clarify their situation they should seek advice on the matter by contacting the Social Security office.
