Notification Of Motor Vehicle Broken Up Or Destroyed / Permanently Exported Notes and Conditions

Note 1. Vehicle broken up / destroyed (scrapped)

This form should be completed to notify us if a vehicle has been scrapped.

You should only notify us that your vehicle has been scrapped if it has been collected by Bulk Refuse OR delivered directly to Guernsey Recycling (scrap yard) or Sarnia Autos (scrap yard).

If you have transferred your vehicle to someone for parts or for use in autocross etc. you should instead transfer the vehicle to that person until the chassis of the vehicle has been disposed of by either Bulk Refuse, Guernsey Recycling or Sarnia Autos.

If you have disposed of the vehicle in any other way, please contact us for advice.

Note 2. Exporting a vehicle

This form should be completed to notify us if a vehicle has been exported.

Please retain the Vehicle Registration Certificate for this vehicle. This will be required when reregistering the vehicle with a foreign authority. Do not send it to us.

If you have lost the current Vehicle Registration Certificate, you will need to apply for a Certificate of Export by completing the relevant section overleaf and paying the £17 fee.

The Certificate of Export can be used to re-register the vehicle in the absence of the Vehicle Registration Certificate. If the vehicle has been sold outside of Guernsey, please provide the new keeper's name and address overleaf and we will issue the Certificate of Export in their name.

Note 3. Retaining a registration mark

If you choose to retain the registration mark for future use, it will be retained in the name of the current registered keeper of the vehicle. The keeper will be issued with a Certificate of Retention for the registration mark. Once a registration mark is retained, it is non-transferrable, meaning that the registration mark can only be allocated to a vehicle registered in the same name.
