

Major Accessions 1996 - 2019

Every year the UK National Archives collects information from over two hundred archives and record repositories in the UK about major collections of records they have received the previous calendar year. This information is added to the National Register of Archives, and is also edited and used to produce thirty-four thematic digests which are made available through the National Archives' website and distributed for publication in a number of learned journals and newsletters. The Island Archives has participated in this survey since 1996 to make available online information about its major collections for researchers.
