The time commitment is around 20 half-days per year and meetings are currently convened once or twice per month.

There will also be opportunities for potential membership on short-term review projects focussing on specific topics.

Whilst there are no formal qualifications required, relevant experience in financial, commercial or legal matters is highly desirable.
