Notes 1-4

1. The legislation enables Driver & Vehicle Licensing (DVL) to grant temporary and permanent Replacement Public Service Vehicle Licences.
(Please refer to the legislation and to the Passenger Transport Governing Policy sections 2.1.3, 2.1.6, 3.1.3 and 4.1.6).
2. Licences must be held by a legal entity. This may be an individual, company or an incorporated company
The licence cannot be held by a partnership or a trading body that is not a registered company. In the case of a registered company the address must be the company address.
(Please refer to the legislation and to the Passenger Transport Governing Policy 2.1.1 and 3.1.1).
3. The legislation enables the DVL to grant a Temporary Vehicle Licence in respect of a vehicle not owned by the applicant, but only in prescribed circumstances and only for a limited period of NOT MORE THAN 60 DAYS
(Please refer to the legislation and to the Passenger Transport Guernsey Policy section 2.1.6 and 3.1.3).
4. Applicants are required to provide information on the vehicle to be used in connection with the licence issued. Where an applicant is unable to provide the information requested, an explanation must be given.
