






In 2016 70% of Secondary school students reported that they had 'NEVER' drunk more than intended






Secondary school students reported on how many times alcohol had caused a problem for them or anyone else in





SEXUAL HEALTH

Year 8 & 10 pupils were asked about their understanding of Sexual Health and the Sexual Health & Contraception Advisory Services in Guernsey. Trends were observed in the responses from 2010, 2013 & 2016.

20% of Year 8 8 78% of Year 10 students know where the Sexual Health Service is located.

25% of Year 8 8 71% of Year 10 students know where the Sexual Health Service is located. 47% of Year 8 8 73% of Year 10 students know where the Sexual Health Service is located.

There has been no change since 2010 regarding the main source of information about sex. Sex and Relationships Education lessons, Parents and Friends remain the 3 main sources of information.

36% of Year 8 8 86% of Year 10 students know where they can get FREE condoms. 19% of Year 8 8 70% of Year 10 students know where they can get FREE condoms. 25% of Year 8 8 90% of Year 10 students know where they can get FREE condoms.










A comparison between 2010, 2013 and 2016

Significant increases in the proportion of students who are worrying about certain issues have been identified in comparison to previous years


The % of Secondary school students who worry about exams has significantly increased since 2013




The % of Secondary school students who worry about school / homework has significantly increased since 2013







Primary school students loneliness while at school has significantly decreased, whilst Secondary schools remains constant




The number of pupils who are 'OFTEN / VERY OFTEN' afraid to attend school due to bullying has remained constant for both Primary and Secondary school students




BODY IMAGE & HEALTH








