<p><b>Minor Category</b></p>	<p>£45:00</p>	<p>This category includes treatments and care such as</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Minor wound management</li> <li>• Management of sprains and strains that require splinting /supports provided.</li> <li>• Management of minor dislocation (Splinted only)</li> <li>• Limb immobilising/ fitting of “boots/Splints”</li> <li>• Provision and Instruction crutches</li> <li>• Insertion of urinary catheter by nurse only (not as part of wider care)</li> <li>• Phlebotomy (Blood Tests) for Primary Care Patients at weekends</li> <li>• Dressings for Primary Care for Primary Care Patients at weekends</li> </ul> <p><b><i>All the care and treatment provided within this category includes the administration of medications required including nebulisers BUT EXCLUDES IV medications</i></b></p>
