**The States resolved as follows concerning Billet d'État No IX
dated 7th April 2017**

ELECTION OF JURAT

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 (2) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended, and section 8 (1) of the Royal Court (Reform) (Guernsey) Law, 2008, an election was held, by secret ballot, for the office of Jurat of the Royal Court to replace Margaret Ann Spaargaren, who ceased to hold office by reason of age on the 17th May 2017.
