Dear Parents,

As we approach the end of term I would like to thank students for all their hard work and parents for your support throughout the year. A particular thanks should go to everyone who has performed recently at St James, Government House, the Open Morning and at Les Cotils. **There will be no further Music Centres this term.**

Any outstanding printed sheet music should be returned to the Music Service office by Friday, 21st July, after which time the office will be closed until the beginning of September.

Lessons

The last day of instrumental teaching in States schools was Wednesday, 12th July so, unless pupils have been informed to the contrary, please assume that lessons have finished for this academic year.

The Music Service fees from September 2017 will be as follows: Music Centre registration will be £93 per year (£62 for the older choirs and £31 for the younger choirs) and fee-payers' lessons £93 per term. The rate for hire of violins and violas for beginners is unchanged at £45 and £70 for brass, woodwind and the lower stringed instruments. These instruments hired beyond the normal hire period will be charged at £100 per annum. Grant Aid is available in certain circumstances.

Developments at Music Centre

Each year we review the operation of Music Centre. We have been very grateful for student helpers at Music Centre who have assisted younger ensembles at Music Centre, sometimes as part of the Duke of Edinburgh Award scheme. Recently a few senior players received some help and advice in developing their conducting skills, so we hope that some will now feel able, if asked, to take sectional and small group rehearsals, both in schools and at Music Centre. We also hope to re-introduce some string quartet playing to Music Centre as another way of pupils taking more responsibility for their learning.

Year 13 Leavers

The staff of the Music Service would like to pass on their very best wishes to all our Y13 pupils who will be leaving us at the end of this term, thank them for their commitment to Music Centre over many years and hope that they will continue with their music-making in adult life.

Some of these Leavers will have the opportunity to take part in one more important Island event before they leave for university or perhaps start work. This is the Service of Reconciliation (see below).
