ELECTION OF JURAT

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 (2) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended, and section 8 (1) of the Royal Court (Reform) (Guernsey) Law, 2008, an election was held, by secret ballot, for the office of Jurat of the Royal Court to replace Terry George Snell, who has been appointed by the Royal Court as Juré-Justicier Suppléant with effect from the 14th July 2017
