Who are we?

We are a team of two children's nurses who are able to provide care and support for you and your child at home, avoiding repeat visits to hospital which can be distressing.

We are based at Lukis House in St Peter Port with the Health Visitors and School Nurses.

We work in partnership with parents, carers and other health professionals, to offer nursing care and support to children and their families in Guernsey.



Who can be referred?

We accept referrals from any Health Care Professional, any child from birth to 16 years old.

If you think your child would benefit from our service, you could speak to a GP or Health Visitor who could speak to us on your behalf



Our work includes;

- Pre-discharge planning with Frossard Ward staff to ensure a smooth transition from hospital to home.
- We will visit, if needed, after your child has had an operation.

- Teaching nursing procedures to children, parents and carers and provision of ongoing support.
- We provide ongoing support and advice as required.
- Additional support for children with complex needs.
- Acting as a resource for information and support for professionals, parents, carers and clients.
- Liaison with UK hospitals on Discharge.
