Under the ESC proposals:


After finishing Year 11 at St Sampson's High Joe moved to the Sixth Form College to study his 4 A Levels.

Alternatively Joe could have moved to site B at 16 to for all 4 A Levels.







Alice wants to study A Levels in Maths, Physics, Design and a BTEC Certificate in Engineering


Under the ESC proposals:

After finishing Year 11 at Les Beaucamps
High Alice can go to the Sixth Form College
and study 3 A Levels alongside the BTEC
Certificate.



Under the Alternative Proposals:

After finishing Year 11 on site A of the secondary school Alice could study her choice of A Levels either across both sites or she could move to site B for all of them. Alice would need to attend the College of FE for the BTEC Certificate.

John would like to be an accountant. John achieved B and C grades in his GCSE exams.


John studied a BTEC Extended Diploma in Business


Under the ESC proposals:

After finishing Year 11 on site B of the secondary school John went to the College of Further Education to study.








Rachel is going to Oxford University to study Law. She achieved A* grades in her GCSE exams.

IB Certificates at the Sixth Form College.


If Rachel had chosen to also do A Levels in History and French she could have studied these at the Sixth Form College.

If Rachel had chosen to also do A Levels in History and French she would have needed to move to School B for all or some of these.






Josh is unsure what he wants to do but wants to keep his options for higher education open. Josh achieved mostly C grades in his GCSE exams.

Josh is studying for A Levels in Film Studies and Photography and a BTEC Extended Certificate in Business


Under the ESC proposals:

Cathy studied for a Level 2 childcare whilst resitting her Maths and English GCSEs. She then went on to study a Level 3 Child Care qualification


Under the ESC proposals:

After finishing Year 11 on site A Cathy moved to the College of Further Education to study.






Charles would like to be a Chef. Charles achieved E, F and G grades in his GCSE exams.

Charles studied Hospitality and Catering whilst working as an apprentice


Under the ESC proposals:
