DISABILITY & INCLUSION STRATEGY - PUBLIC HEARING

The Scrutiny Management Committee is holding its next public hearing on the Disability & Inclusion Strategy on Wednesday 31st January 2018. The hearing will seek to explore progress being made on the Disability & Inclusion Strategy, together with the management of public resources.

The public hearing will feature: representatives from the Policy & Resources Committee, the Committee for Employment & Social Security and the Guernsey Disability Alliance, together with the States' 'Disability Champion' Deputy Sarah Hansmann-Rouxel. It will be held in the Moulin Huet & Petit Port Rooms at St Martins Community Centre between 14:00 and 16:00 hours on Wednesday 31st January 2018.

The Panel will comprise Deputy Chris Green (Chair), Deputy Peter Roffey and Non-States Member Advocate Peter Harwood.

This is a formal parliamentary proceeding and therefore members of the public are welcome to attend in an observational capacity, but are not able to ask questions or make any comment whilst the hearing is in progress.

The President of the Scrutiny Management Committee, Deputy Chris Green, commented:

"This public hearing is an opportunity to examine the degree of progress being made on the Disability & Inclusion Strategy by the key Government Committees together with relevant third party organisations".
