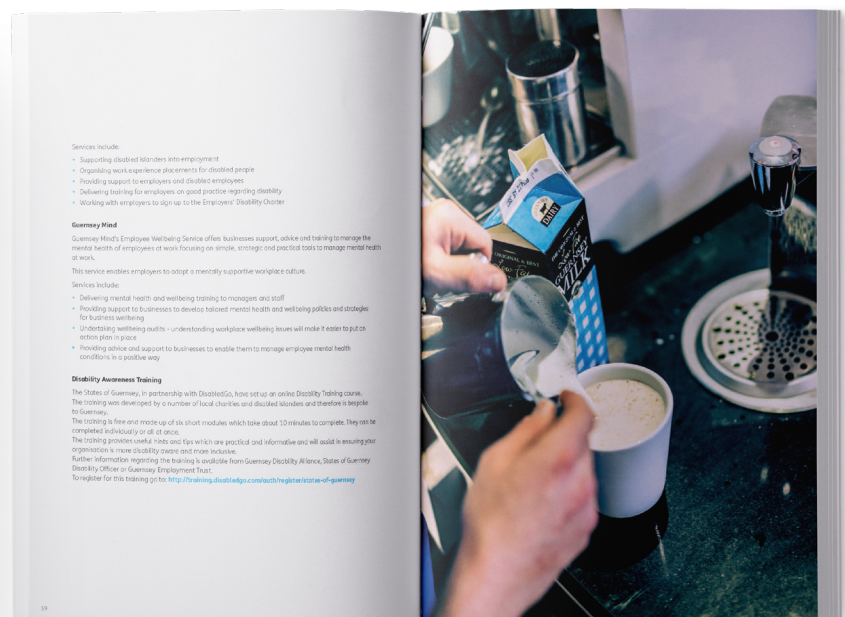

To work towards this, GET produced a Good Practice Guide for Employers to provide guidance on the recruitment and retention of disabled people. This guide is intended to be used as a reference document for employers who wish to maximise the potential of disabled people, who are a workforce with a huge range of experience and skills.

GET also run free workshops entitled 'Employment and Disability – A Practical Approach for Employers.' These workshops are aimed at Human Resources/Personnel Managers, Line Managers, Supervisors, those with recruitment and selection responsibilities and staff dealing with employment issues in the workplace. The three hour session covers barriers faced by disabled people and concerns from employers looking to recruit from the disabled community,
