*1A To:-*

- a) *rescind Resolution 5 of 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 on Article III of Billet d'État V of 2017, insofar as it:-*
  - i. *directs the Policy & Resources Committee to make available a loan from the proceeds of the States of Guernsey Bond Issue (of December 2014) to fund the initial capital costs of the new waste management facilities and services referred to in that resolution; and*
  - ii. *directs the States' Trading Supervisory Board to fund the related loan interest and capital repayments from the Solid Waste Trading Account;*
- b) *approve a capital vote of a maximum of £32million, charged to the Capital Reserve, to fund a grant to the Solid Waste Trading Account of the capital costs of new solid waste management facilities and services required for the implementation of the island's solid waste strategy as referred to in Resolution 4 of 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 on Article III of Billet d'État V of 2017; including the repayment of any amounts advanced from the loan from the States of Guernsey Bond issue (of December 2014) together with any interest accrued and associated charges; and*
- c) *rescind Resolution 7 of 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 on Article III of Billet d'État V of 2017 insofar as it directs the States' Trading Supervisory Board to recover the capital costs referred to in paragraph b) from charges made to householders, businesses and other users of waste management services.*
