Important update to Employment Permits

Open Market Part C – Residential Care Homes

- If you are new to Guernsey or already a resident you can now be granted a Discretionary Resident Permit for Open Market Part C which means you can live and work full-time in any property listed as Part C.
- You do not need to live and work in the same property.
- You do not need to take a break in residence before applying another Discretionary Resident Permit to live and work in Part C.
- There is no limit on the length of time you can live and work in Part C.

Please note, though, that time spent living in Part C of the Open Market does not count towards your qualification for permanent residence in Guernsey or accessing the local market.
