Children (Resident in Guernsey, Alderney or Herm - Under 18)

£25 Payment required at time of consultation

For children, payment will be required at the time of their consultation, regardless of whether or not they have medical insurance. Those on income support will continue to have their attendance and consultation funded by Employment & Social Security and, therefore, will not need to pay for their consultation at the time.

This subsidised charge is the same regardless of severity or time of consultation and only applies to children resident in Guernsey, Alderney or Herm, or is available to children resident in Guernsey, Alderney or Herm, and whose parent/guardian is actively paying Guernsey Social Insurance contributions.



You can pay for your ED treatment at the time by visiting our Reception team after you have been discharged from ED.

We accept card payments and cheques but regret we cannot take cash.

You will receive an itemised receipt when paying at Reception which can be used to claim from your medical insurance.

If you are a visitor to Guernsey please pay on discharge from the Emergency Department.

Invoices for non-payment at the time of treatment will be issued and are strictly 30 days from the date of invoice.

Charges net of £12 grant payable by The Committee for Health & Social Care. Visitors (adults or children) from areas not covered by a reciprocal agreement with Guernsey, will be subject to a 50% surcharge and be additional to any diagnostic charges incurred.
