

Our ambition is to be the leading example of great 'Island' Maternity Services




Our Vision

- Inviting partners to stay overnight & provision of new partner beds
- Better ratio of midwifery staff to mothers
- Midwifery leader on duty 24/7
- Consultant Obstetrician on site 24/7

Priority/Aspiration 1—Co-production;

By development and encouragement of true partnership working with the community and the Maternity Voices group. Demonstrating that women and families are the heart of everything we do.

Successful Outputs:

- Valued community and service user events
- Maternity Voices/Service User involvement in recruitment of Midwives
- Maternity Voices representatives welcomed and invited to the unit and unit events
- Feedback illustrates HSC department have listened and acted upon user feedback



Priority/Aspiration 2—Fresh new Maternity Environment;

To move towards a new maternity environment that is modern, and equipped to support natural birth and births with complexity which require the input and support of specialist obstetric care. An environment with spaces that protect privacy and comfort for women and their families.

Successful Outputs:

 Families and professionals report the environment enhances their time spent in the Maternity unit.

Priority/Aspiration 3—No compromise on continuity;

Women will be cared for by small teams of professionals. These teams will provide continuity for the woman and will co-ordinate care which ever pathway it is following and which ever professional service it interacts with.

Successful Outputs:

- Reduction in numbers of healthcare professionals a women interacts with during her maternity experience.
- Staff report higher levels of satisfaction

Priority/Aspiration 4—Personalised care for all women;

All women will have a personalised care package that meets their needs and wishes, to ensure safe satisfying experiences, cared for by confident kind staff who are known to the woman and her family

Successful Outputs:

- All women have a PCP (prescribed care package)
- Reduction in complaints/feedback about communication and attitude

Priority/Aspiration 5—Priority on Postnatal Care;

Improve postnatal services that are accessible and have emphasis on flexible personalised packages, enabling more support for those families who have extra needs adjusting to new family life taking greater care of perinatal mental health and wellbeing

Successful Outputs:

- More choices available to women in respect of postnatal care in terms of who, where, when
- Families who need more support will have packages beyond 10 days

Priority/Aspiration 6—Improved Public Health for women and their families;

All families will have access to a personalised programme of Public health information and projects that support and enable them to make the lifestyle choices that will have positive long term impacts on their personal and families' future health. Consistent Public health messages will be delivered by the maternity team, supported by Public health specialists, with innovative and engaging projects designed around the needs of the service user

Successful Outputs:

- Formal audit of the uptake and outcome of programmes and service user feedback
- Reduction in service users booking with concerning Public health lifestyle choices
