**AMENDMENT**

After Proposition 28, to insert the following:

“28A. To direct the Committee *for the* Environment & Infrastructure, in consultation with the Policy & Resources Committee, as part of its development of an over-arching energy policy to include consideration of environmental and energy related taxes and explore ways to help ensure that there is a sustainable tax base from this source, designed to preserve current revenues, which is supportive of the Island’s approach to energy and to report back with progress by no later than March 2020.”

**Explanatory Note**

This amendment is placed to replace part 4 of the amendment numbered 22 submitted by Deputies Merrett and Tooley. That amendment seeks to establish a States Investigation & Advisory Committee to consider the best way of raising sustainable revenues in respect of motor vehicles.

This amendment recognises that responsibility for policy with regard to this matter rests with the Committee *for the* Environment & Infrastructure and requires that Committee, in line with its mandate, to explore future sustainable taxation as part of its work on the energy policy for the States.
