### **BROCK UNIVERSITY GRADUATE DEGREE (POSTGRADUATE) SCHOLARSHIP 2018 ENTRY**

#### **Information Sheet for Applicants**

Brock University in Canada is offering one Scholarship to a person ordinarily resident in Guernsey, Alderney or Herm wishing to pursue a graduate degree (postgraduate) course commencing in the autumn term of 2018. The University will meet the tuition fees of the Scholarship holder.

#### **Courses and Course Information**

Brock University offers a variety of postgraduate courses leading to a master's degree. In duration the courses are either one or two years.

Persons wishing to apply for the Scholarship are advised to contact the relevant department at Brock University to find out if their current qualifications are acceptable for entry to the postgraduate course of their choice.

#### **Financial Support**

The University Scholarship will cover the cost of the tuition fees.

Education Services will award a travel grant to cover the cost of one trans-Atlantic return fare per year for a postgraduate scholar, subject to the student's successful postgraduate application through the Services' postgraduate grant scheme.

Assistance towards the student's living and other travelling costs may be available through the Education Services' Higher Education Postgraduate Awards Scheme and will be subject to the normal income assessment.

All MA/PhD funding is available on a competitive basis for 2018/2019 and applicants will be able to apply to Education Services accordingly, but this will mean that students are required to gain a first class undergraduate degree or, as a minimum, a 2:1. In addition, applicants will be asked to explain why their course of postgraduate study is essential for their choice of career. It is likely that there will be limited funds available and, if necessary, other factors, such as academic and other achievements, and the benefit to the Bailiwick, may also be taken into consideration when assessing applications for postgraduate funding from Education Services to be received by 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018.

The grants system will continue in 2018/2019, although the allowances will be revised.

#### **Applications for the Scholarship**

Applications for the postgraduate scholarship should be submitted on-line.

Once the application fee is received at OUAC, their application will be released to Brock University.

Applicants should identify the fact that they have applied for the Brock University Guernsey Scholarship within the Personal Information area of their on-line application. Students should also mention in their letter of intent that they have applied for the Brock University Guernsey Postgraduate Scholarship.

**The closing date for postgraduate scholarship applications is 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2017.**
