The HPV Vaccine that protects against Cervical Cancer and Genital Warts is being offered to all 12 and 13 year old Year 8 girls in school by the School Nurses. Committee for Health and Social Care (HSC) offers vaccination with the vaccine called Gardasil and it is free of charge.

Girls will be offered two doses of the vaccine, one year apart, as per current vaccine administration guidelines.
