## Application to keep a Pet Dog

The intention is to provide those tasked with assessing the suitability of a potential dog owner with a framework of points to raise. This document could be used either as an application form or a check list to go through when undertaking a 'home visit'. Information in blue boxes is provided as a catalyst for conversation and deeper consideration of the risks and responsibilities of dog ownership. The potential dog owner will be asked to sign and date the form to encourage them to provide truthful information. This document can be amended by animal welfare organisations, breeders or landlords to suit their individual needs.
