## Guidance on completing this form

- 1. Before completing your appeal form you are strongly recommended to read the guidance notes on the Parochial Appeals Tribunal to assist you in preparing your appeal. Copies of all the legislation and guidance notes can be found on the States website at <a href="https://www.gov.gg/pat.">www.gov.gg/pat</a>. Electronic and paper copies are also available from the Secretary to the Parochial Appeals Tribunal contact details below. Your Parish may also have paper copies of the appeals forms.
- 2. The legal deadlines for submitting appeals to the Parochial Appeals Tribunal are as follows:
  - (a) Refusal of a Bornement 28 days, commencing on the date of the letter from the Parish advising of its decision made under Article 36 or 37 of L'Ordonnance ayant rapport à la Construction de Maisons, Salles Publiques et Bâtiments, et au Tracement de Routes et Chemins, 1931;
  - (b) Warning Notices for failure to cut a roadside hedge or clear a watercourse 7 days, commencing on the date of any Warning Notices issued under section 1A(1) of the Cutting of Hedges Ordinance, 1953 or section 8 of the Loi relative aux Douits, 1936;
  - (c) Civil Penalties for failure to cut a roadside hedge or clear a watercourse 14 days, commencing on the date of any Civil Penalty issued by the Parish under section 1A(4) of the Cutting of Hedges Ordinance, 1953 or section 8 of the Loi relative aux Douits, 1936;
  - (d) Notices advising of the Parish's intention to carry out work on an uncleared watercourse 7 days, commencing on the date of the notice issued by the Parish under section 9 of the Loi relative aux Douits, 1936.
- 4. Please complete a separate form for each appeal, e.g. if you are appealing a Warning Notice issued under the Loi relative aux Douits, 1936 and one issued under the Cutting of Hedges Ordinance, 1953, you should complete two separate forms even if it is for the same site.
- 5. Please complete all relevant sections of this form and attach all the supporting material, together with the administrative fee of £25. Your cheque should be made payable to the "States of Guernsey".
- 6 If you do not provide the necessary evidential documentation with this application form then it may delay your appeal.
