Jobseekers without work	311	DECREASE IN THE NUMBER OF JOBSEEKERS The average number of jobseekers without work was 311. This compares with 322 for the last quarter and 297 for the same quarter in 2018. This is a decrease of 11 on the quarter and an increase of 14 compared to this time last year.

Jobseekers with some work	431	MORE PEOPLE CLAIMING A TOP-UP There were also 431 people jobseeking and doing some work. This number includes people in part-time or casual employment. This compares with 411 in the last quarter and 381 in the same quarter last year.			
Turnover in Claims	29	FEWER CLAIMS STARTED THAN ENDED There were 325 jobseekers at the beginning of this quarter. During the quarter 104 jobseekers made new claims and 133 ended claims. The number of jobseekers at the end of the quarter was 296 and therefore a decrease of 29.			
People on training schemes	46	TRAINING SCHEMES AND PLACEMENTS There were 46 people on training schemes such as CEPS, Work to Benefit, Kickstart and placements with the third sector.
