BRITISH NATIONALITY ACT 1981

NOTICE TO PERSONS APPLYING FOR BRITISH CITIZENSHIP IN THE BAILIWICK OF GUERNSEY

(This should be read in addition to the Guide for Applicants)

You must ensure that you understand and satisfy the legal requirements to qualify for naturalisation or registration as a British citizen. These requirements are explained in the guidance notes that accompany the application form. Fees are not fully refundable for applications that fail.

Under the nationality laws of some countries a person will automatically lose his or her nationality if he or she becomes a citizen of another country. If you have any questions about this, you should ask the authorities of the country of which you are a citizen <u>before</u> making your application for British citizenship.

Good Character Requirements

One of the criteria that a person must satisfy when applying for British citizenship is that he or she is of 'good character', which includes a person's financial obligations to the States of Guernsey. To help demonstrate the good character requirement, please ensure that you complete the enclosed letter of consent which is addressed to the Director of the Revenue Service. Once completed please send directly to that office, not back to Immigration & Nationality.

Biometrics

All applicants are required to submit biometrics as part of the application process. Once you have submitted an application, you will receive a letter inviting you to attend this office in order for biometrics to be submitted. Please contact this office to make an appointment for this to be arranged. When attending, you will need to bring the letter with you along with your passport.
