Electric trike and cargo bike subsidy

A second electric cycle subsidy scheme is being launched on Saturday 4th April 2020, focusing on e-trikes and e-cargo bikes – both of which can play a useful role in improving mobility choices. Although e-trikes, and e-cargo bikes in particular, are potentially a game-changer in terms of zero-emissions transport, cost is still a major barrier – which is what this initiative aims to overcome.

A public/private initiative between the Committee *for the* Environment & Infrastructure and three participating cycle retailers, this latest scheme will promote the use of electric trikes and electric cargo bikes as alternative modes of transport. Islanders will be offered a 25% discount on e-trikes up to the purchase value of £2,000 and on e-cargo bikes up to the purchase value of £3,500.

The States of Guernsey will offer a 20% subsidy towards the purchase of an electric trike or electric cargo bike, with the cycle retailers making up the remaining 5%.

Applicants will be required to register for participation in the scheme at the local cycle retailers and will be asked to participate in two feedback surveys over the course of a twelve-month period. These surveys will build up valuable information on the use of these modes of transport, and will help the Committee to measure the success of this initiative.

Anyone over the age of 14 who lives in Guernsey is eligible to take part in the initiative. Proof of I.D. is required at the point of sale and customers may only purchase one e-trike or e-cargo bike under the scheme.

Appendix A – How does the e-trike and e-cargo bike purchase initiative work?

- 1) Customer goes to one of the local participating cycle retailers and selects their E-trike or E-cargo bike;
- 2) Cycle retailer asks for sight of each customer's I.D. to validate their identity* customer's name, address details, email and details of e-trike or e-cargo bike are entered on to the on-line portal, cycle retailer prints copy of information, customer signs information to accept the transaction;
- 3) Retailer supplies the e-trike or e-cargo bike to the customer and carries out a full handover explaining the functionality and controls and offers an orientation test ride;
- 4) Customer enjoys their new e-trike or e-cargo bike!
 - 5) Customer has their e-trike or e-cargo bike checked over for FREE by the supplying retailer within three months of the purchase date and completes (via email) the 6 and 12 month surveys.

* Customers who do not have photo I.D. will be required to provide a photograph, signed on the reverse by an acceptable signatory, stating that the person photographed is whom they claim. Acceptable signatory being as listed on attached list.

Customer requirements:

- 4 Children over 14 years of age but under 18 must have parental/guardian consent, along with I.D. (see below ;)
- Guernsey resident (lived in the Bailiwick of Guernsey for 185 days a year) show proof of Guernsey passport or Guernsey driving licence, or for those without a passport or driving licence, a passport style photo dated and signed by an acceptable signatory and copy of documentation proving residency such as a utility bill or bank statement dated within the previous 3 months;
- 4 Eligible to purchase one E trike or E cargo bike from only one of the participating local cycle retailers;
- 4 Customer signs Customer Form printed by the retailer at the time of purchase;
- **E** cycle check within 3 months of purchase and completion of surveys.

Retailer requirements:

- 4 Add details of each E trike or E cargo bike purchase into the on line portal;
- **4** Adhere to the highest maintenance and safety standards (as per signed agreement);
- Remind participants of the initiative to have their e cycles checked for free within 3 months of purchase;
- 4 Input details as required into the national <u>www.bikeregister.com</u> database;
- **4** Participate in any media activity to help support the initiative if called upon to do so.
