## **Dedicated Coronavirus Helplines**

Two dedicated helpline numbers have been released today for Islanders to use if they have any clinical questions regarding the coronavirus. The numbers are:

## 01481 756938 and 01481 756969

These two numbers will be manned between **8am and 10pm** every day and are being manned by trained call handlers from the Joint Emergency Services Control Centre (JESCC).

Anyone who requires medical help in an emergency should call 999.
