# Direction of the Committee for Home Affairs issued under the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Control of Premises) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020

This Direction imposes prohibitions, restrictions and requirements on certain premises licensed under the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006 ("the Ordinance").

This Direction has effect <u>from</u> 6.30pm on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March <u>until</u> 11:59pm on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March.

Premises are described in this Direction by reference to categories of liquor licence issued under the Ordinance, as set out in the First Schedule to the Ordinance.

In this Direction, a "meal" means plated cooked or prepared food served on the premises.

The Committee for Home Affairs directs as follows:

## **CATEGORY E premises (Nightclubs)**

Category E premises must close.

## **CATEGORY A premises (Standard Licence)**

### Permitted hours of opening and restrictions

11:30am to 2.30pm – customers must be seated at tables and alcohol may only be served with, and ancillary to, a meal.

6:30pm to 10:30pm – customers must be seated at tables and alcohol may only be served with, and ancillary to, a meal.

## **<u>CATEGORY D premises (Club Licence – Private members)</u>**

#### **Restrictions**

Customers must be seated at tables and alcohol may only be served with, and ancillary to, a meal.

Members may only sign in two guests at any one time.
