**Proposed installation of cycle canopy – Smith Street, St Peter Port**

Please find enclosed application to install a cycle parking canopy at the prescribed location. With regard to this planning application, we would like to offer the following additional supporting information.

The proposed installation accords with the States approved "*Integrated Transport Strategy*", in as much as it supports the desire to provide more environmentally sustainable transport infrastructure options for public use.

The application also accords with 12.7.6 & 7 in The Island Development Plan (2016) in as much as it encourages the use of bicycles, an alternative and sustainable form of transport.

The area is popular with commuting cyclists as it is one of the main areas for cycle parking in the vicinity.

Consultations have taken place with Agriculture and Land Management Service as they have oversight of the area, the service has raised no objections to the development and is supportive of the initiative.

While ideally a fully enclosed shelter would have been preferable, Traffic and Highway Services are mindful of the limited space availability as such a cantilevered roof only option would be the most suitable solution. The chosen style has a low profile roof and will be constructed to fit the available space.

The following information shows details on the proposed style and standards for the canopy chosen, along with details for the proposed sites. This information should be read in conjunction with the appended application form and details.



The adjacent photograph shows the 'Essex' cantilevered cycle canopy that T&HS propose to install on various sites in St Peter Port.

Note: Existing cycle hoops will be used so there will be no requirement for the integral hoops shown in the picture.

The base will be root fixed so there will be no requirement for the feet as shown in this example.



The site chosen is at the top of Smith Street covering the existing cycle hoops at the entrance to the sunken gardens.
