SESSIONS DELIVERED BY SHARE

YEAR 5

2 sessions

- Pupils will understand some ways to stay safe and healthy and the importance of good personal hygiene.
- Introduce the concept of puberty and promote a healthy attitude towards growing up and identify who to ask for help (gender split).

YEAR 6

3 sessions

- Emotions, self-esteem and growing up.
- Body changes at puberty, coping with them and accessing help and advice.
- Baby in the family.

YEAR 7

2 sessions

- Extend prior knowledge on emotional and physical changes at puberty and related issues & where to access help & advice (gender split).
- Expand prior knowledge on conception, foetal development and birth, parenthood and family responsibilities.

YEAR 8

2 sessions

- Healthy relationships, sexuality, consent, exploitation and abuse.
- Pressures on teenagers to have sex and consequences of unintended teen pregnancy.

YEAR 9

3 sessions

- To explore choices and consequences of a sexual relationship, consent and the law, and to understand that abstinence is a choice.
- Keeping safe in a sexual relationship and accessing help and advice.
- To provide up to date information on HIV and Chlamydia and to promote a safe attitude towards sexual health.

YEAR 10

3 sessions

- Healthy relationships and contraception suitable for young people.
- STIs diagnosis and treatment and where to access help and advice
- To explore unintended pregnancy and the options available and where to obtain help and advice

YEAR 11

3 sessions

- To raise awareness of some male and female cancers, being body aware and know where to access help and advice. (gender split)
- Healthy relationships, risk taking, and sexual health update. Help & advice
- The effects on relationships in a digital world, including pornography and sexting.

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 7 BOYS PUBERTY

LESSON AIM

To extend prior knowledge on the emotional and physical changes during puberty, & discuss concerns about puberty and related issues.

OBJECTIVES

- Pupils will improve their knowledge of the male reproductive system.
- Pupils will learn about the physical and emotional changes experienced during puberty, and associated gender issues.
- Pupils will learn to cope with personal issues, hygiene and where to access help and advice.

STRATEGY

- Introduce self and session
- Ground rules
- Round or brainstorm on changes at puberty
- Activity/ cards /group work on physical and emotional changes ahead, body image and the positives of growing up
- Male anatomy & physiology with posters on smart board
- Film clips on puberty/growing up
- Question time and where to access help & advice

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 7 GIRLS PUBERTY

LESSON AIM To extend prior knowledge on the emotional and physical

changes during puberty, menstruation management, and related

issues.

OBJECTIVES

- Pupils will improve their knowledge of the female reproductive system.
- Pupils will learn about the physical and emotional changes experienced during puberty, and associated gender issues.
- Pupils will feel confident toward menstruation management, personal hygiene and related issues and know where to access help and advice.

STRATEGY

- Introduce self and session
- Ground rules
- o Round or brainstorm on changes at puberty
- Activity/cards/group work on coping with puberty changes
- o Anatomy& physiology revised with posters on theSmartboard
- o Menstruation management and film clip about coping at home and at school
- o Body Image and a brief discussion on the positives of growing up
- Question time and where to access help & advice

RESOURCES

Discussion cards and posters, body image pictures, film clips, pads (reusable and disposable) and tampons, leaflets.

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 7 REPRODUCTION

LESSON AIM

To expand prior knowledge of conception, foetal development and birth, relationships within parenthood and family responsibilities.

OBJECTIVES

- Pupils will further their understanding of conception, foetal development and birth.
- Pupils will learn about parenting, including the father's role, and the importance of planning a family.
- Pupils will identify where to obtain medical help and advice.

STRATEGY

- Introduce self and session
- Ground rules
- Round/activity or discussion on parenting considerations, families and fathers role.
- o Male & female anatomy & physiology revised.
- Conception, foetal development and birth with posters and models & reproduction film
- o Questions/discussion

Foetal models, reproduction film, activity/cards on parenting.

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 8.1 HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS

LESSON AIM

To develop understanding of different relationships and pressures on teenagers to be in a sexual relationship.

OBJECTIVES

- Pupils will be able to identify some qualities needed for a healthy relationship.
- Pupils will learn the importance of love, respect and commitment in a sexual relationship, the law and consent.
- Pupils will learn that abstinence is a choice, and identify some good reasons for young people to delay having a sexual relationship.
- Pupils will know who to ask for help and advice.

STRATEGY

- Introduce self and session
- Ground rules
- Brainstorm Healthy relationships and what does sex mean?
- Healthy relationships film clip,
- o First sex film clip on pressures young people face
- Law and consent with Keynote & Film clips
- Where to obtain help & advice
- Questions/discussion

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 8.2 HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS & TEEN PARENTS

LESSON AIM

To identify, the pressures young people face to have a sex and some of the challenges teen parents could have.

OBJECTIVES

- Pupils will be able to identify the qualities needed for good parenting including the father's role and planning a family.
- Pupils will learn and the importance of love and commitment in a sexual relationship, that abstinence is a choice, and list some good reasons to wait for sex.
- Pupils will know where to access professional help and advice relating to pregnancy and family planning.

STRATEGY

- Introduce self and session
- Ground rules
- Brainstorm what parents need to think about before having a baby
- "Underage and pregnant" Film clips & Keynote slides
- Group discussion/activity on pressures on young people to have sex and the importance of planning a family and waiting for sex.
- Where to access help & advice
- Questions/discussion

Relationship activity cards, film clips, Keynote presentation, leaflets.

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 9.1 CHOICES IN A RELATIONSHIP

SESSION AIM

To understand the responsibilities, choices and consequences of sexual relationships.

OBJECTIVES

- Students will learn the qualities needed for a successful relationship and understand some pressures young people might experience.
- Students will learn that abstinence is a choice and to take a responsible attitude when considering a sexual relationship.
- Students will understand the meaning of consent and the law regarding sex and young people.
- Students will know where to access help and advice.

STRATEGY

- o Introduce self and session
- Ground rules
- Film clips on relationships the law and consent, slides % of teens in sexual relationships etc.
- APAUSE activity on the board why do some young people have sex and what stops them?
- o Clinics, help and advice
- Question time

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 9.2 KEEPING SAFE IN A SEXUAL RELATIONSHIP

SESSION AIM

Pupils will have the knowledge and skills to keep safe and healthy in a sexual relationship.

OBJECTIVES

- Students will have knowledge of reliable contraception suitable for young people including emergency contraception.
- Students will revise signs of pregnancy and will learn about safe and effective condom use.
- Students will know where to seek professional help and advice.

STRATEGY

- Introduce self and session
- Ground rules
 Film clip on relationships, clips on teen pregnancy and reasons to wait for sex
- Year 9 Contraceptive posters, leaflets and cards in packs
- Condom demo and practise for mature students in friendship groups
- Where to access help and advice
- Question time

Films, leaflets info packs models and condoms, relationship posters.

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 9.3 INTRODUCTION TO SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED INFECTIONS

LESSON AIM

To provide up to date information about HIV and Chlamydia

OBJECTIVES

- Pupils will learn about HIV & AIDS and know how HIV is transmitted and prevented.
- Pupils will have an understanding of how Chlamydia is diagnosed and treated.
- Pupils will learn where to obtain help and advice.

STRATEGY

- o Introduce self and session with Educate & celebrate poster
- Ground rules
- Brainstorm STIs on the board/paper
- o HIV presentation and film clip
- o Chlamydia Film showing clinic visit
- o Quiz on chlamydia testing and treatment
- o Where to access help and advice

RESOURCES

Board markers, HIV presentation, Chlamydia film, quiz, leaflets, (red ribbons in autumn term)

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 10.1 CONTRACEPTION

LESSON AIM

To expand prior learning of contraception and its effectiveness.

OBJECTIVES

- Pupils will improve their understanding of sexuality and the importance of healthy, committed and safe relationships.
- Pupils will learn that there are choices and consequences within a relationship, and be reminded that abstinence is a choice.
- Pupils will learn about contraception including emergency contraception.
- Pupils will improve their knowledge of safe condom use and about the use of Emergency Contraception and its availability.
- Pupils will know where to seek professional help and advice locally and online.

STRATEGY

- o Introduce self and session with Educate and Celebrate relationships poster
- Ground rules
- o Relationships safe and healthy discussion cards
- Film clips on the Law and Consent
- Contraceptive matching card activity
- Clinics/help and advice
- o Quiz

RESOURCES

Relationship card activity, contraceptive cards, condoms, models etc. leaflets.

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 10.2 SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED INFECTIONS

LESSON AIM

To provide information about the most common STI's and where to obtain professional advice and treatment.

OBJECTIVES:

- Pupils will learn about the most common STI's and how they are transmitted.
- Pupils will learn about signs and symptoms of infection and that some STI's can have no symptoms.
- Pupils will learn that condoms & dams can help prevent transmission of STIs.
- Pupils will know where to obtain professional advice and treatment.

STRATEGY AND ACTIVITIES.

- Introduce self and session
- Ground rules
- o STIs brainstorm on board or activity/discussion
- o Film clip covering viral, bacterial and parasitic infections
- o Condom demonstration/practise with models and condoms
- STI info packs in groups
- o Clinics/treatment and accessing help and advice and
- Questions

STI info packs, films, STI quiz, pencils and board markers, condoms and models, testing demonstration kit, leaflets.

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 10.3 UNINTENDED PREGNANCY

LESSON AIM

To explore unintended teen pregnancy and the options and support available.

OBJECTIVES:

- Pupils will further their understanding of conception and signs of pregnancy.
- Pupils will understand that support and values are required for good parenting, the choices available and the importance of planning a family.
- Pupils will know where to obtain professional help and advice.

STRATEGY AND ACTIVITIES.

- Introduce self and session
- Ground rules
- Activity/discussion on parenting considerations
- o Presentation on signs of pregnancy and the choices available
- o Film clip on teen pregnancy and the difficulties they face.
- Where to access help and advice
- Questions

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 11.1 CANCER AWARENESS & SELF EXAMINATION

LESSON AIM

To raise the awareness of cancer, to highlight the importance of self examination and to promote a positive attitude towards sexual health.

OBJECTIVES

- Students will understand the importance of making healthy lifestyle choices.
- Students will learn some signs/symptoms of cancer and that self-examination is one of the most effective ways to detect some cancers early.
- Students will gain an insight into the possible treatments and procedures related to cancer.
- Girls will understand the importance of the HPV vaccine, regular sexual health check-ups including cervical screening.
- Boys will understand the importance of protecting their testicles during some sports.
- Students will know where to go for help and advice

STRATEGY

- Introduce self and session
- Ground rules
- Warm up discussion on healthy lifestyles'
- Film clip/s on cancer awareness
- o Examination techniques using film clips and models
- Sexual health reminder
- Where to access help and advice
- o Quiz & question time

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 11.2 SEXUAL HEALTH UPDATE

SESSION AIM

To provide up to date information and encourage a mature attitude towards sexual health.

OBJECTIVES

- Students will be able to state some important qualities in healthy relationships.
- Students will learn that sexual health could be compromised by influences such as low self-esteem, alcohol and the digital world.
- Students will know how to protect themselves from pregnancy and STIs and where to access professional help and advice

STRATEGY

- Introduce self and session with the Educate and Celebrate poster
- o Ground rules
- Relationship activity/discussion cards
- o Film clips on alcohol/risk taking
- Alcohol specs activity with condom use to highlight potential risks
- Sexual health update/reminder
- Where to access help and advice
- o Quiz

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 11.3 HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS IN A DIGITAL WORLD

SESSION AIM

To provide up to date information and encourage a mature attitude towards relationships and the digital world

OBJECTIVES

- Students will be able to state some important qualities for a healthy relationship.
- Students will learn that sexual health and emotional well-being could be compromised by influences such as low self-esteem, peer pressure, media and the digital world, including social media sexting and pornography.
- Students will know how to cope with these pressures to be safe and know where to access professional help and advice

STRATEGY

- Introduce self and session and Ground rules
- o Relationships in a digital world discussion define 'relationship'
- Porn fantasy/reality card activity 'Fantasy Vs Reality' and effect of porn on relationships
- o Pornography and the law, consent and child protection
- o Film clips on the dangers of sexting pornography and addiction
- Body image i.e. shaved body hair/surgery and pressures to conform/Help and advice

SESSION TITLE: YEAR 12.1 POST 16 SEXUAL HEALTH WORKSHOP

SESSION AIM

To provide up to date information and encourage a mature attitude towards sexual health.

OBJECTIVES

- Students will state some qualities in a healthy relationship and know the law regarding sex.
- Students will learn that sexual health could be compromised by influences such as low self-esteem, pressure from others, substances, alcohol and the digital world.
- Students will know how to protect themselves from pregnancy and STIs. Know about signs of pregnancy, the local abortion law and where to access help and advice.

STRATEGY

- Introduce self and session
- Ground rules
- Sexual health Quiz sheets to music
- o Identify healthy relationships and see the Law and consent films
- o Contraceptive reminder PP, Signs of pregnancy and local abortion law
- o STI film or slide presentation and condom recap
- Porn and digital safety with film clips
- Help and advice/clinics update/reminder
- o Qs & As
