REQUEST UNDER THE CODE OF PRACTICE FOR ACCESS TO PUBLIC INFORMATION

Request sent on 21 July 2020:

I would like to request the following information under the Code of Practice for Access to Public Information:

I would like to know, the number of 'routine' operations (knee, hip etc) that have been undertaken/carried out at the PEH since the lifting of the lockdown in late June?

States of Guernsey response sent on 30 July 2020:

The Bailiwick moved into Phase 5 of the Exit from Lockdown on 20 June. At this time, services began to return to 'business as usual' with some restrictions still in place at the Hospital e.g. increased time between theatre slots to distance patients from each other.

The data in the table below shows all routine operations carried out from 20th June 2020 to 26th July 2020 where the patient was under contract (i.e. not private patients) and was not an emergency case.
