Notes:-

- 1. The figures above relate to planning applications and appeals made under the Land Planning and Development (Guernsey) Law, 2005 ('The 2005 Law').
- 2. Speed of decision is measured in terms of the period between receipt of the valid application and the actual issue (i.e. posting out) of the formal decision notice (not the time between receipt of the application and the making of the decision, which will be slightly shorter).
- 3. Speed of decision on 'householder' applications. These are generally more minor applications for domestic development.
- 4. The "Appeal rate" includes appeals received within the period and pending the decision of the Planning Panel.
 - An "Appeal result" statistic has not been included for this first quarter due to the small number of appeals determined so far this year.
- 5. Performance statistics including the 1st & 2nd quarter of the year will be available in October 2020.
