Re. Replacement of mechanical ventilation following fire damage

Regarding the above, we enclose the full application and the following information.

1. The replacement mechanical fan units are high efficiency motors, and the unit casings consists of an aluminium frame surrounded with galvanised steel panels with 20mm wool insulation to offer a low sound level.
2. The system is provided with an odour neutraliser system designed to treat cooking odours produced by commercial kitchen extracts. The system omits an odour chemical within the ductwork which bonds with the malodour produced by the cooking equipment and neutralises any smells produced.
3. Operating times of the fans will run during the cooking times of the restaurant approximately 1600 – 2300
4. The ventilation is merely replacing the old existing ventilation but with newer, more efficient units.
