



Freedom of Information Appeals Panel Membership

The Scrutiny Management Committee is seeking expressions of interest from local residents wishing to be considered for membership of its Freedom of Information Appeals Panel.

The Freedom of Information Panel will be an independent appeal body to be established by 1st January 2022. The Panel will provide an independent appeals process which is accessible to all and offers a fair and transparent determination of an appeal on the application of exemptions under the existing Code of Practice on Access to Public Information.

The Panel will comprise five persons including a Chair, Deputy Chair and three ordinary members. It is anticipated that at least two of the members will be legally qualified. Sitting members of the States are not eligible to serve on the Panel. The initial term of office will be for four years and will commence in January 2022.
