





Advancing Professional Practice Level 7 -15 Credits

Frameworks are emerging across the UK to support Health and Social Care Professionals to extend their expertise and scope of practice, including the development of Advanced Practice Roles. This module will enable students to analyse the concepts of Advanced Practice, including the 'Four Pillars' identified within these frameworks: clinical practice, facilitating learning, leadership, and research and development (NHS 2017). They will apply this to identify how their own area of practice can be advanced. This module is suitable for all health and social care practitioners who wish to develop their knowledge and skills in a specific aspect of their role, including recognition as an Advanced Practitioner.

Module Content:

- Definitions of the term advanced practice
- Scope of advanced practice roles including teaching, leadership and research
- Inter-collaborative practice
- Theory and concepts under-pinning advanced practice
- Critically evaluating and reviewing the evidence base
- The legal, ethical and professional dimensions of advanced practice
- Governance structures, ensuring safe and quality practice, promoting service improvements
- Identifying learning needs, planning and delivering teaching sessions, assessing competence
