

End of Life Care Level 5 (20 Credits)

End-of-life care encompasses a range of conditions including cancers, dementia, heart disease and neurological conditions, and in the UK someone dies every minute. This module is for all registered health and social care staff who support such individuals.

Using the key end-of-life care policy documents this module will encourage students to develop their existing knowledge and understanding of contemporary end-of-life care provision including holistic assessment.

Module Content:

- Consider the philosophy and development of end-of-life care provision including the social and political trends affecting clinical practice
- Evaluate and analyse the concepts of wellbeing and resilience and determine how they can be fostered both in patients and yourself.
- Debate the ethical and legal issues that influences care of the dying patient.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the challenges associated with the provision of end-of-life care and the strategies available for service improvement.
- Determine the role of the individual practitioner in providing holistic evidence-based care to meet the needs of patient/service users with life-limiting illnesses and their carers
