





# MASTERS IN PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE

This 3 year programme aims to equip you with the knowledge and skills to plan and deliver services within the dynamic context of professional practice. This programme will be open to all professionals, with the option to study pathways in leadership, education or advanced practice. On completion of this programme the successful student will be able to:

- 1) Use critical reflection to facilitate transformational learning in self and others
- 2) Develop creativity, originality and strategic thought.
- 3) Critically analyse complex, incomplete or contradictory evidence/data and judge the appropriateness of the enquiry methodologies used.
- 4) Synthesise information from disparate sources to identify opportunities to transform and improve services.
- 5) Critically analyse and propose solutions to work based problems evaluating their strategic alignment with organisational priorities.

#### **Semester 2 (February to June)**
