



PDUK 5-Day Patient Assessment Skills Workshop 6th to 10th September 2022

This five-day course provides health professionals with a 'springboard' for diagnostic proficiency and clinical decision making to advance practice. After studying basic history taking and physical examination techniques, you will have the opportunity to perform a complete physical examination reflecting clinical practice requirements supporting the development of competence and confidence. The course mainly focuses on adult patients.

Aims/Outcomes:

- Learn and use the principles of taking a safe, structured patient history.
- Be able to apply physical examination techniques in an appropriate manner for each of the major body systems
- Perform a complete structured physical examination
- Identify normal and common abnormal findings encountered while conducting a patient examination
- Document findings in a clear, concise manner
