

Policy, Strategy and Planning Level 7 - 30 credits

This module has been designed to enable the student to gain insight into how policy is developed, implemented and evaluated within the international, national and local context. Students will develop the ability to critically analyse local and national policy, and consider how this is used to shape national and local strategy. Students will use this working knowledge to provide a report that will identify an area of practice that could be developed to better align service delivery to local policy.
