





POST GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION

This one-year programme will enable students to develop their professional expertise and political awareness to contribute to service development within an education context. This programme will be open to all professionals in a role that involves adult education.

The programme aims to equip individuals with the knowledge and skills needed to plan and deliver services within the dynamic context of professional practice by enabling the student to:

- Develop their professional expertise and political awareness through critical reflection on their practice as educators
- Synthesise and evaluate new theoretical and practice-based knowledge which contributes to professional and service development within their sphere of practice.
