To insert the following proposition 20:

“20. To direct all Principal Committees, Scrutiny Management Committee, Development & Planning Authority and the States’ Trading Supervisory Board to identify opportunities for joint working with Jersey which could generate revenue savings or efficiencies; and to direct the Policy & Resources Committee to include a report on the work undertaken and any proposals for progressing identified opportunities in the Government Work Plan 2023.”

**Rule 4(1) Information**

- a) The proposition contributes to the States’ objectives and policy plans by seeking to identify opportunities for revenue savings and efficiencies.
- b) In preparing the proposition, consultation has been taken with Treasury.
- c) The proposition(s) have been submitted to His Majesty’s Procureur for advice on any legal or constitutional implications.
- d) There are not expected to be any direct financial implications to the States of carrying the proposal into effect.

### **Explanatory note**

Recent meetings with Deputy Kirsten Morel has identified a desire for the Islands to work together on matters of regulation and where savings and efficiencies could be made.

The Presidents of the Committee for Economic Development, Home Affairs and Education Sport and Culture were present, along with the Chief Minister and the Lead for External Relations.

As the cost of running the Islands continue to rise; there is no better time to focus our political minds of where we can work together to reduce the burden of government on the taxpayer.
