How to respond:

The Scrutiny Management Committee (SMC) working with the States Assembly & Constitution Committee (SACC) are calling for evidence regarding the main areas indicated within the 'Review Scope' section of the Terms of Reference.

Any member of the public is invited to submit evidence to this review.

The review panel expect that all submissions are clearly marked with the name and contact details of the sender. Anonymous evidence will not be considered by the review.

Evidence should, wherever possible, be submitted by e-mail to scrutiny@gov.gg – any documents should ideally be in Word or PDF format.

Letters can be sent to the address provided at the end of this document. Please do not send any original documents.

Confidentiality:

Anyone submitting evidence to the Review should do so on the basis that their evidence may be published alongside the final report at the conclusion of the Review.

However, those submitting evidence to the Review may request that their evidence remains confidential. Such evidence should be clearly marked "Private and Confidential". It should be made clear when the submission is provided why the correspondent wishes the information to be confidential. Valid reasons will allow the evidence to be considered on this basis as part of the review process.

All submissions, including confidential submissions, will be destroyed at the conclusion of the Review. For further information on how we manage your data please see the Scrutiny Management Committee's Fair Processing Notice at gov.gg/scrutiny.
