## **ELECTION OF JURAT**

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 (2) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended, and section 9 (1) of the Royal Court (Reform) (Guernsey) Law, 2008, an election was held, by secret ballot, for the office of Jurat of the Royal Court to replace David James Mortimer who ceased to be a Jurat with effect from the 20th December, 2022.
