Brain Bleeds and Stroke Data

Request:

Please provide data on younger people (aged under 55 years) who have suffered with brain bleeds/strokes over the last 2 months.

Response provided by The Committee for Health & Social Care:

The table below shows the number of patients, aged 55 years or under, who have been coded with having either a stroke or bleed between 2018 and 2022.

There are no patients aged 55 years or under that have been coded with either a stroke or bleed so far in 2023, although it can take some time for data to be available in such a way that it can be reported fully. Records are up to date to the end of 2022.

A stroke or bleed includes:

- Cerebral infarction
- Transient cerebral ischaemic attack
- Intracerebral haemorrhage
- Subarachnoid haemorrhage
- Subdural haemorrhage
- Stroke, not specified as haemorrhage or infarction
