Rule 4(1) Information

- a) The proposition contributes to the States’ objectives and policy plans in line with the priorities set out in the Government Work Plan specifically looking at sustainable, economic growth and resilience.

- b) In preparing the proposition, no direct consultation has been undertaken with relevant stakeholders but the current debate in the States of Deliberation has been taken into account.
- c) The propositions have been submitted to His Majesty's Procureur for advice on any legal or constitutional implications.
- d) The financial implications to the States of carrying the proposal into effect are unlikely to exceed £25,000.
